## NON RUNNER AFTER DECLARATION TO RUN – BHA RACE ENTRY CODE

[this guidance does not cover double declarations]

Trainer must immediately submit a **non-runner notice**:

- ➤ HORSE IS ON RACECOURSE to the clerk of scales, if present
- > ANY OTHER TIME to the Racing Calendar Office through the Racing Administration Website or by telephone

**THE NON-RUNNER NOTICE** must state the reason why the horse is a non-runner and cannot be withdrawn.

## **PENALTY RANGE – applied by the recourse stewards**

There is no penalty where the reason is one set out in the rules and in the case of "other" acceptable to the stewards, and the notification requirements have been met as above. In other circumstances, the penalty is as follows:

Non runner - £140.00

If the horse is made a non-runner after 9am on the day of the race this increases to £500.

The penalty could be further increased if there is considered to be a wilful disregard of interest to racegoers taking account of the nature of offence and importance of race. This is a £500 entry point, with a range of fine £250 - £2,000.

Failure to notify of non-runner - penalty £500
