

Trainers with Gold accreditation in 2021 who want to enter other sections of the Excellence Awards or improve from Standard to Gold

The 2022 Lycetts Leadership & Team Champions Awards have launched!

As a Gold accredited Trainer, you do not have to formally re-enter the Lycetts Leadership Award this year. Your accreditation lasts for two years, and 2022 logos and plaques will be issued to you automatically.

If you would like to be considered for Gold accreditation in other sections of the Excellence Awards or be considered for the overall Lycetts Leadership Award you will need to formally re-enter, and you have until **Friday 8 April** to get your entries in.

We would really encourage you to get involved again this year. Your entry was of a very high standard and having the opportunity of being Gold accredited in more areas and shortlisted in the Lycetts Leadership Award presents a great opportunity to showcase your yard to potential staff, owners and sponsors. In many cases the marks were very close to the benchmark. Simply tweaking some of your answers or improving your anecdotes could help improve your mark to achieve a Gold accreditation.

How to enter

Award categories:

- **Lycetts Leadership Award**

This award is for licensed British trainers. There are four sections that make up the Lycetts Leadership Award and all are Excellence Awards. These sections are based on The Winning Approach, a set of industry standards in management and employment practices. Trainers can enter just one or multiple sections.

Prize: £4,000 awaits the winning Trainer to spend on their business

- **Lycetts Team Champions Award**

This award provides an opportunity for racing staff to tell us about their team and to gain the recognition they deserve. The Lycetts Team Champions Award recognises and celebrates the best teams on racehorse training yards, regardless of the size of the yard and from the staff's perspective.
